

Parking Information for ePermit Users

1. ANU Parking permits can be purchased online on <https://epermits-anu.orikan.tech/ssp/u>
2. Permit holders may include up to three vehicles on their permit, however, only one vehicle is able to be parked on campus on any given day. Parking more than one vehicle on campus on a given day may result in an infringement notice being issued. 3. Permit holders may park in You may park in relevant paid parking area where the signs include the words "Permit Holders". This is dependent on the type of permit you have purchased. For instance, if you have purchased a parking station permit, you may only park in said parking station. If you have purchased a surface permit, you may park in any surface permit areas.
4. A permit is not a guarantee of a parking space. It is a permission to park on campus. Note that parking spaces fill up quickly on campus.
5. Permits **cannot be renewed within two weeks** of cancellation without approval from parking office.
6. Permits are for the sole user of the permit holder.
7. You may not park in Resident, Authorised, Reserved, Restricted or Mobility parking bays. Cars may not park in motor bike bays. Full list of infringements can be found online: <https://services.anu.edu.au/campus-environment/transport-parking/parking-infringements-and-penalties>
