### Comcare GHS Support Tools and Resources.



**Risk: Just under two months to prepare for full implementation!**

With just under two months to prepare for the full implementation of the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS), which will be mandatory from 1 January 2017.

Comcare has developed tools and resources to assist workplaces to prepare their teams for the changes, some of these tools are:

- Labelling of Workplace Hazardous Chemicals and Safety Data Sheets (SDS) – brief explanation of requirements with links to Code of Practice;
- Advise for duty holders – information under the WHS Act on implementing the GHS;
- Printable GHS ‘are you ready’ posters – great visual displays for the workplace
- E Learning GHS workplace awareness training and introduction to GHS video.
- Quick guides – information on what you need to know about GHS in the workplace; and
- GHS FAQs – commonly asked questions relating to GHS.
