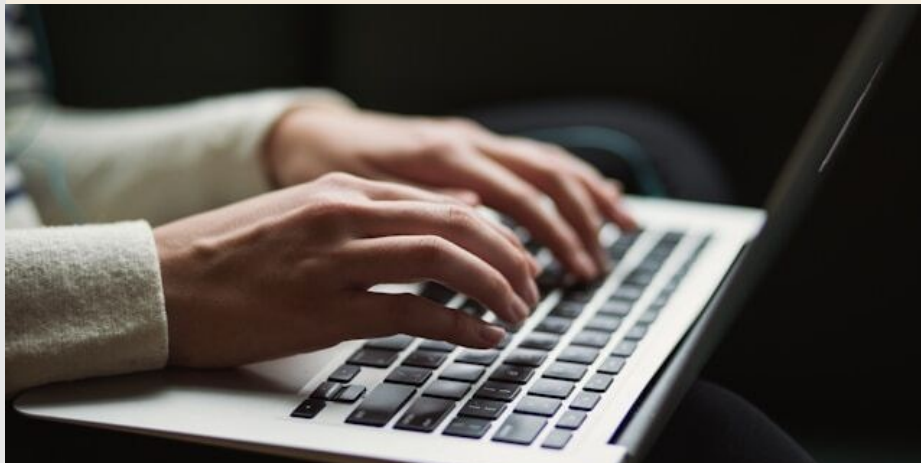
Journal Article Writing (JAW) Boot Camp
