3. Professor Tim Wess

Professor Tim Wess, Executive Dean, Faculty of Science at Charles Sturt University (CSU) spoke to the SAT about his experiences of Athena SWAN. Professor Wess is CSU's Athena SWAN academic project lead and previously led the School of Optometry and Vision Sciences at Cardiff University to a departmental silver Athena SWAN award in the UK. He is also a member of the SAGE National Advisory Panel. Some of Professor Wess' advice for the bronze application was to:

- Identify and focus on points that differentiate ANU from other universities.
- Break the data down to school levels. Avoid only showing high level data which may hide problem areas
- Acknowledge that different areas within the university have different contexts/circumstances and will
 require different actions.
- Be direct about areas of poor practice and clearly identify how it will be corrected in the action plan.
- Don't wait for the action plan to be complete before implementing simple changes.
- Provide staff data to review before consulting on the application.
- Use the culture section (question 5.4i) of the application to discuss best practice.

Professor Wess asked the SAT to discuss some of the ways ANU differs from other universities. At first the SAT discussed how several of the University's problems are similar to others:

- Overall ANU has 50% female staff but this hides gender inequalities in different schools, colleges and service divisions.
- Each area in ANU is different, for example:
 - Engineering has a low level of women entering the pipeline.

 Biology has a high number at the undergraduate level but still has relative low levels of female professors.

They then identified some points of difference:

- There is strong support from the Vice-Chancellor which makes change easier.
- There is a high percentage of academic staff who obtained their PhD at ANU.
- ANU is research focused meaning more staff are on contingent grant funding (as opposed to teaching intensive universities) and anecdotally there are more women in this position but it is yet to be confirmed quantitatively.

4. Project Update

Ms Sara Rowley updated the SAT on the SAGE Project as follows:

- The project plan will be finalised and distributed soon.
- The rest of the SAT meetings will have a theme based on the application:
 - These themes will be communicated to the wider ANU community via the equity committees, the ANU Athena SWAN website, and the VC's blog.
 - We will ask for submission and feedback on each theme.
 - Notes from the SAT meetings will be shared via ANU Athena SWAN website and open for comment.
 - At the next meeting the SAGE project team will be presenting data from the "A Picture of the Institution" section of the application.
- Data sub-group terms of reference have been distributed and any SAT members may join.
- Feedback on the cultural survey showed that a clearer direction is needed before it is finalised and implemented.
