## **Academic Selection Criteria**

The following table is to be used as a guide only in determining suitable selection criteria for academic positions at the various levels. It may not be appropriate to call for every one of the capabilities listed for each level, as the requirements for each job will vary.

These criteria cover the more general capabilities that are relevant for academic positions. Some positions may require additional criteria calling for specific and/or specialist expertise such as experience with laboratory or research techniques. These may be most appropriate as included with the 'research' criterion as a specific aspect of the research capabilities.

In determining suitable criteria, the Minimum Standards for Academic Levels, set out in <u>Schedule 4</u> of the ANU Enterprise Agreement 2010-2012 should be consulted.
