## What is fraud?

Fraud is dishonestly obtaining a benefit, or causing a loss. It could include theft of assets, false invoices, taking or offering a bribe, undeclared conflicts of interest, dishonestly releasing information and misuse of University resources.

We're all responsible for taking action when we suspect fraud. It's our reputation and integrity that's at risk if we turn a blind eye.
