

Parking Information for vPermit Users



You may park in any paid parking area where the signs include the works "Permit Holders".

You may not park in a parking station without a valid parking station permit.

A permit is not guarantee of a parking space it is permission to park on campus. If you arrive after 8:30am you may find difficult to find somewhere to park.

Permits cannot be renewed within two weeks of cancellation without approval from the Parking Office.

Permits are for the sole use of the permit holder.



You may not park in Resident, Authorised, Reserved, Restricted or Mobility parking bays. The penalty for parking illegally in a mobility bay is \$640.00 as at 4 July 2023. Cars may not park in motor bike bays.



You may not exceed the time limit in a time limited zone.



You may not park near a yellow edge line, this offence carries a \$297.00 penalty as at 4 July 2023.



You may not park on the landscape i.e. on grass, gutters, footpaths etc.



You may not park in Pay & Display car parks (these have different signs to the Paid Parking signs) without purchasing a voucher from the machine and displaying it on the dashboard of your vehicle.

Car parks may have multiple zones within their boundary. Please read all signs before parking.
