


To Set up a Turnitin assignment

<p><b>Submission Type</b></p> <p>Student submissions can either be an uploaded file or a text submission.</p> <p>File upload – enables students to upload files in the following formats: doc, docx, pdf, rtf and txt.</p> <p>Text submission – enables students to type in their answers into a text area for submission to Turnitin.</p> <p>Any Submission Type – both options will be available to the students.</p>	
<p><b>Number of Parts</b></p> <p>This option creates a multi-part assignment. If your assignment requires 2 or more submissions, select the number of papers to be submitted from the <b>Number of Parts</b> drop-down menu.</p> <p>Students will be able to upload a file into each Part.</p>	
<p><b>Maximum File Size</b></p> <p>This option sets the file size limit of your students' submissions.</p> <p>Note: Although the site upload limit for Wattle is 2GB, Turnitin has a separate limit of 40MB. The file size is capped at 40MB which is the maximum allowed file size for file uploads to Turnitin.</p>	

<p><b>Allow submission of any file type</b></p> <p>This option changes the file types students can upload to the Turnitin assignment.</p> <p><b>If set to:</b></p> <p><b>No</b> – it allows writing file types that Turnitin can check for originality report, such as Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, WordPerfect, PDF, RTF, OpenOffice (ODT) and plain text files.</p> <p><b>Yes</b> – it allows non-writing file types, such as image files. <p><b>Display Originality Reports to Students</b></p> <p>This option controls the availability of the originality report to the student.</p> <p><b>If set to:</b></p> <p><b>Yes</b> – the student may view the originality report generated by Turnitin when they submit their assignment.</p> <p><b>No</b> – the originality report is not available for the student to view and only available for lecturers to view.</p>	 <p>The screenshot shows the following settings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Allow submission of any file type?</b>: No</li> <li><b>Display Originality Reports to Students</b>: Yes (selected)</li> <li><b>Auto Refresh Grades / Scores</b>: Yes, automatically refresh</li> <li><b>Displayed user fields</b>: Full name</li> </ul>

ASSIGNMENT PARTS	
<p><b>Assignment Part 1</b></p> <p>You can update the name of the part and the relevant dates for the assignment.</p> <p><b>Name</b> – the default is Part 1. It can be changed to a more meaningful name.</p> <p><b>Start Date</b> – it determines the earliest time a student can make a submission to that assignment part.</p> <p><b>Due Date</b> – it determines the date by which time the student must submit their work. If allowing late submissions, submissions made after this date will be marked in red to show a late submission.</p> <p><b>Post Date</b> – it determines when marks/grades will be released to students. The Post Date must be after the Start Date but can be set before the Due Date.</p> <p><b>Max Marks</b> – numeric points can be entered. It must be between 0 and 100. <p><b>Report Generation Speed</b></p> <p>There are 3 options in generating Originality Reports for student submissions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Generate reports immediately (resubmissions are not allowed)</b> – The Originality Report is generated immediately after the student submits the assignment. It does not allow resubmission of the assignment.</li> <li><b>2. Generate reports immediately (resubmissions are allowed until due date)</b> – The student can resubmit the assignment until the due date. The Originality Report for the first submission is generated immediately. Originality Reports for the second and subsequent submissions are generated after 24 hours. <i>(Recommended setting)</i></li> <li><b>3.
